Your recent contribution to the "HTG/STOP LA ROUCHE" campaign effort is gratefully acknowledged. We realize that this donation represents your concern and your commitment that this dangerous initiative be soundly defeated. Your support and that of other H.T.G. members will mean that the High Tech Gay organization will play a significant role in the county fund raising effort and in the eventual success of the campaign to defeat the LaRouche initiative.

Many organizations, in addition to H.T.G., are working in conjunction with the county "NO ON 64" campaign. Some of the recent developments in the campaign are outlined below, as are some upcoming events.

- * Donations to the H.T.G. fund-raising goal of \$5000.00 have reached 30% after only two weeks.
- * The Santa Clara County "NO ON 64" campaign headquarters will be in full operation by Sept. 3rd (presently part-time only). The phone number is 408-292-0370.
- * The Headquarters' grand opening/fund-raiser party will be Sept. 7th from 2 - 4 p.m. at the Billie DeFrank Community Center. Tickets are \$10.00 per person. Please come !
- * Voter registration drives are underway in many areas of the community. Every gay man and lesbian in this state should register and vote, even if the only votes cast are for Rose Bird and against the LaRouche initiative. Both are vital to our future freedom.
- * Baymec is very busy with fund-raisers, speeches at non-gay functions, and requests to city and county governing bodies to oppose the LaRouche initiative. The response has been very favorable.
- * Several \$100.00 per person fund-raisers are being planned locally for the near future. One will offer an opportunity to hobnob with many local and state level elected officials, while another will have a Hollywood celebrity as a guest speaker.

- * Wiggys Siversten, Rich Gordon and Paul Wysocki are all serving on the statewide "NO ON 64" campaign committee.
- * Statewide polls show that the public in general is uninformed about the facts pertaining to AIDS as it relates to the initiative. Thus, heavy emphasis on medical facts and strong support from the medical community will be required during this campaign. Fortunately, a majority of civic and community leaders are speaking out against this initiative.
