20. Immigration issues.

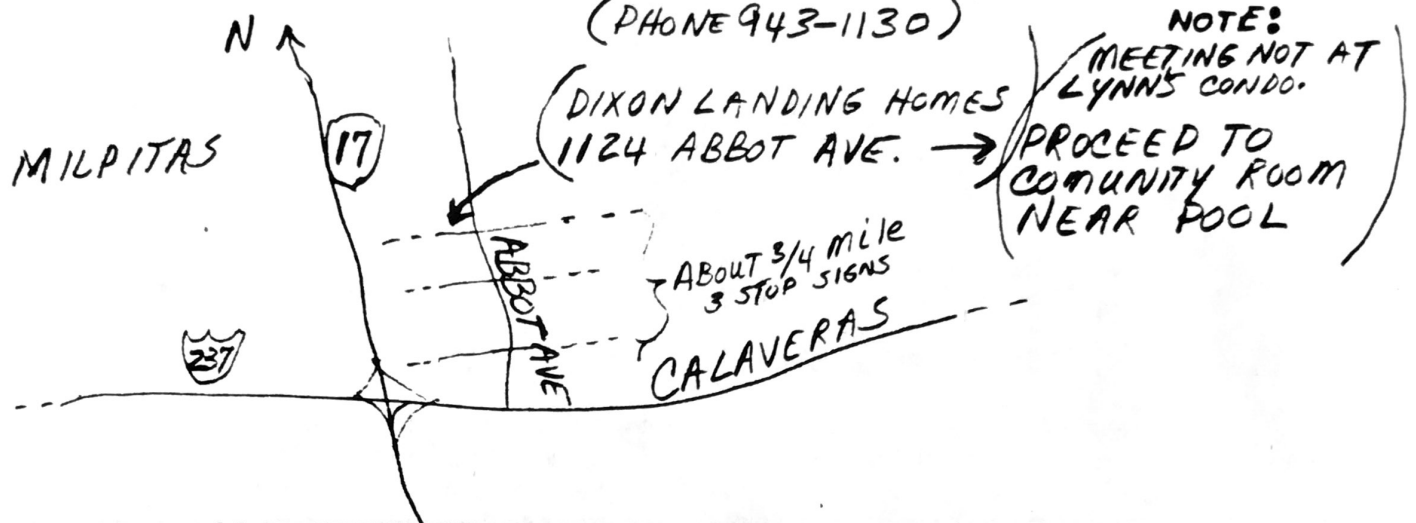
